




जी 20 के बाद अब देश की प्रॉब्लम 20 पर ध्यान जरूरी

भारत ने जी20 का आयोजन कर अंतर्राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर अपनी अच्छी खासी साख कायम की, हमारे प्रधानमंत्री नरेंद्र भाई मोदी विश्व के प्रमुख नेताओं में शामिल कर लिए गए, जी-20 के 20 देशों के नेताओं के साथ साउथ अफ्रीका के प्रधानमंत्री ने भी इस सम्मेलन में शिरकत की और इसके संयोजक प्रधानमंत्री नरेंद्र मोदी तीन दिन तक काफी सुखिज्यों में भी रहे, उनकी आन, बान और शान में काफी अभिवृद्धि हुई। किंतु अब भारत में संपन्न इस सफल आयोजन के बाद भारतवासियों की अपने प्रधानमंत्री से यह अपेक्षा है कि अब वह अपने अंतर्राष्ट्रीय लगाओं को कुछ समय के लिए त्याग कर अपने स्वयं के देश की बेरोजगारी, महंगाई गरीबी जैसी पी20 (प्रॉब्लम 20) पर विशेष ध्यान दें और 100 दिन बाद होने वाले चुनाव के लिए अपनी जमीन, अपने देश में पक्की करें, जिससे कि उनकी जनहितैषी योजनाओं के बल पर वे पुनः तीसरी बार इस देश के सबोज्ज्वल प्रशासनिक सिंहासन पर आसूढ़ हो सकें।

India's forest policy needs revaluation

Any so-called economic development at the cost of forests is going to invariably hit vulnerable groups who depend on them

The vast expanses of forests, covering India's diverse terrains, are not just mere geographical entities. They are the unsung guardians of our planet, playing a monumental role in mitigating attrition of ecological services and climate change threats. Forests are better known as buffers against extreme weather patterns, ensuring consistent water supply, curbing soil erosion, and aiding in sustainable agricultural practices. Besides these, they stand as vital habitats for the majestic wildlife of India, from awe-inspiring tigers to vivid avian species, amphibians, and the insect world. Their loss could mean a stark decline in biodiversity, damaging the intricate ecological systems, and endangering countless life forms including humans. Less discussed, however, is the fact that humanity has relied on forests, as a primary source of sustenance with a plethora of foods derived through various inventive methods. In modern times, our diet largely revolves around just thirty domesticated species: with rice, wheat, and maize alone making up over half of global calorie consumption. Every domesticated species has its 'mother plant' in the forest, the gene pool in its purest form. The decline in wild food resources due to anthropogenic forces and the fading knowledge of their harvesting and processing have led to the shrinking of the variety that populates the human food system. Any crisis because of harm to the cultivated crops on account of development of immunity of pests to pesticides, or due to climate change will simply be catastrophic. Integrating wild

edible plants into mainstream diets needs to be explored as it will have the potential of significant implications for environmental sustainability, especially in a world grappling with food scarcity challenges. Given this, the need to conserve forests at any cost can hardly be overstated.

While many underprivileged households often depend on monotonous staple diets provided by government initiatives, the tradition and reliance on wild foods and indigenous medicinal systems remain strong, particularly in remote, and e conomically



challenged areas. Any so-called economic development at the cost of forests is going to invariably hit these vulnerable groups, and converting forests indiscriminately into basically low-productivity agricultural lands through encroachments and regularization thereof by Governments for short-term gains needs to be stopped forthwith. For most laymen, forests are primarily vast tracts populated by trees and wildlife. The Forest Survey of India (FSI) paints a more intricate picture while it indicates and includes in the forest cover any territory spanning over a

hectare, with a canopy coverage exceeding 10%. According to their latest biennial report, India's forest cover encompasses about 22% of its terrain. This definition and its true contribution to the ecological security of India, though, do raise eyebrows.

The importance of large, continuous forests cannot be matched by the simple summation of smaller, fragmented forest covers, even if they hold equivalent area metrics in the name of compensatory plantations done instead of natural forests diverted for non-forestry purposes under the

provisions of the Forest Conservation Act 1980 of India. Ignoring this crucial aspect also contributes to the undervaluation of natural forests and could prompt a decreased emphasis so far as the protection and conservation of natural forests are concerned. One can notice a predominant trend of weakening of the forestry sector. The Global Forest Watch showcases a concerning trend: between 2002 to 2020, India lost around 3,490 sq. km of natural forests. The Forest Conservation Bill 2023 has recently relaxed conditions required for the diversion of forests

for non-forestry purposes in many areas of the country. The penal provisions of the Indian Forest Act 1927 have been amended by legislating a separate Act in the name of The Jan Vishwas (amendment of provisions) Act 2023 lowering the punishments for the offences related to setting fire to cattle trespass and grazing in forest areas. The Biological Diversity (Amendment) Act 2023 has 'decriminalized' the offences whereby the offenders can get away by simply paying a penalty amount. While aiming to meet the objective of promoting bamboo plantations in private areas, the Indian Forest Act 1927 was amended in 2018 which deleted bamboo from the definition of timber making it felling a 'non-offence' under this Act in the Reserved Forests. At the heart of the conundrum lies the challenge of appropriately valuing all the goods and ecological services provided by forests and incorporating the same while planning for and assessing economic development. The current economic approaches fail to recognize the contributions of forests which aren't translatable into strict market terms. Forward and backward economic linkages related to forest produce including medicinal plants and also provision of livelihoods to forest dwellers and local communities remain either ignored or unquantified. The critical role in maintaining the water balance in the catchment areas as well as ensuring perennial flow in streams is grossly overlooked. Carbon sequestration and its role in the mitigation of climate change are also not comprehensively accounted for.




IMPORTANCE OF EDUCATING SCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN ABOUT SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT


INTRODUCTION:-

China's trepidation is conjectural

The India-China spat about who requested a meeting between President Xi Jinping and Prime Minister Modi during the BRICS meeting is unfortunate. We have still not understood China's mentality. As a people, the Chinese do not take religion seriously. It is said they have Taoism for breakfast, Confucianism for lunch and Buddhism for dinner and that too as good conduct for living and not channels of faith, far lesser as explanations of life. In times of anxiety, the Chinese have no divine to seek, unlike the Hindus who have karma. The Chinese civilization has not developed sufficiently to have a script for their language. They have thousands of pictographs, rather like when the humans began to learn to write in caves. Despite ideas in simple pictures; they have no alphabet. The Chinese therefore, in many areas are driven by emotions rather than reason. Pride matters more than facts; conceding that they requested a meeting with PM Modi means China's need is greater than India's, unacceptable when mentioned in public. The Chinese end of the scale must be higher than anyone else's.

One shouldn't bargain with a Chinese businessman or shopkeeper. At most, say that his property or item is beautiful, but I cannot afford it. That protects his pride; it conveys, that I am not rich enough. Such things are beyond Indians' imagination.

Britain ruled Hong Kong until 1997. Till World War II, it dominated China's southern provinces around Canton (now Guangzhou). The rulers mostly preferred Indian Sikhs for their constabulary, who discovered the common Chinese dreaded a kick on their backsides. This discovery made con-



stabulary effective for the enforcement of law and order. Those Chinese of the region who recollect the constabulary do not like Indians. India's image after the humiliating defeat of 1962 in the border war is still remembered by the Chinese. They believed they had "shown India its place." The Chinese are still unable to reconcile to the fact that India is no longer afraid of them, or that they can no longer be dismissive or disrespectful towards us.

Look at how China began its economic rise. It picked on the building industry i.e., real estate, boosting its cement and steel industries, plus other building materials besides providing a great number of jobs. Build, build and build was China's mantra. Roads, highways, parks and buildings were the result of this government-driven construction boom. Their regime also resorted to building residential houses by the thousand.

In 2001, I travelled by car 300 kilometres from Shanghai on a magnificent highway and saw thousands of ten-storeyed residential buildings on my way back at night-time. I was surprised to see very few lights in

those buildings, indicating that most flats were unoccupied. Millions more apartments must have been constructed after 2001. It's a moot question how many have found buyers. Would Indians have the boldness to go on a construction spree of this scale without worrying about buyers?

China's industry has followed a similar path. Land and factories were leased at virtually no cost. Term loans were granted for acquiring machinery at an interest rate of 1 or 2 per cent. The promoter(s) was assured of zero labour trouble, the only expectation from him was to export about 75 per cent of his production to earn hard currency. These were not exports but dumping. Yet, despite the rules of the World Trade Organization (WTO), the world, including the USA, Europe and India imported these goods in the name of free trade.

India still imports about USD 100 billion worth of goods from China annually, comprising raw materials and consumer goods. Our exports to China are only about USD 30 billion. The Chinese cannot understand the

contradiction between our treating them as both geopolitical adversaries and trading partners. My own experience in industry has taught me that there is no such thing as an indispensable supplier. If the alternative supplier charges a higher price, an efficient manufacturer can find a way of adjusting the cost of production, offsetting the higher cost in another area of production. One doesn't let oneself go out of business. Buying Chinese because it is cheaper is an escapist action for a lazy manufacturer.

On the consumer goods front, how many items are indispensable? If we compare ourselves with the USA which is doing the same as what we are, this is simply incorrect. America has no geopolitical quarrel of the nature of a boundary dispute. Moreover, it is incomparably richer than us and can afford the luxury of this laziness. This conveys to the Chinese that trade is far more important than recovering territory. Jawaharlal Nehru even said in Parliament; "Not a blade of grass grows there (Aksai Chin) meaning, that territory is not vital to India.

Owing to their linear and rather one-track thinking, and the lack of understanding of the complexities of life, the Chinese cannot comprehend that the Hindu can both grasp and harmoniously co-exist with them. Given this insularity and absolute lack of freedom, it is no surprise that China sees India's recent success and march to prosperity as something to be afraid of, as the latter has amply demonstrated that a free and open society can deliver the designed outcomes. China's hostility towards us has to be seen in this light.

G20 has galvanised manufacturing sector

India's G20 presidency presents an opportunity to strengthen the country's collaboration and economy. With the world's most powerful countries represented, the G20 forum provides a premier platform for international economic cooperation, accounting for 85% of global GDP and 75% of trade. The timing of the Presidency is ideal for India to exercise greater influence on global policies and the economic sector.

The Business 20 (B20) is a G20 dialogue forum that has conducted a year-long series of summits, which saw the participation of Indian and global industry leaders. One of the significant outcomes of the G20 is the 'India-Middle East-Europe Economic Corridor', A cost-effective cross-border ship-to-rail transit network that will connect India to the Arabian Gulf countries, the European Union and the USA, expected to translate into trade and investment opportunities for Indian businesses, supporting global expansion to counter China's Belt and Road Initiative(BRI).

India is making strides towards becoming a leading global manufacturing hub, but there is still room for improvement. Outsourcing has increased due to China's diversion of manufacturing and production to new locations. This has resulted in India becoming a preferred choice for companies seeking alternative manufacturing or sourc-

ing bases. With Indo-US deals taking centre stage and other global corporations following suit, India's manufacturing sector has the potential to reach US\$1 trillion by 2030, making it the fourth largest in the world. Currently, it is the fifth largest.

The manufacturing sector in India has made significant progress since the economy liberalised in the early 1990s. Initially, India was caught between capital-intensive countries like the US, Japan, and Europe, and labour-intensive countries like China. However, India has found its place through low-cost automation, which has enabled world-class quality and scale in some sectors such as automobiles and auto components. This was accomplished under the umbrella of Total Quality Management (TQM), which focused on quality, cost, delivery, safety, morale, and the environment.

India's economic growth relies heavily on industries such as automotive, engineering, chemicals, pharmaceuticals, renewable energy, and consumer durables, making manufacturing a crucial component of the country's progress. Not only does the manufacturing sector have the potential to boost economic growth, but it also can provide employment opportunities for a vast number of the country's young workforce. However, despite its potential, the manufacturing

sector has only been contributing 13-17% of GDP over the past four decades. To achieve India's national target of increasing manufacturing's contribution to 25% of GDP by 2025, the sector must export goods worth US\$ 1 trillion by 2030, which will help India become the third-largest economy.

Unfortunately, India's manufacturing sector has struggled to increase its share of global export of merchandise to 2%. Its share has remained below 2% since 1948, hovering between 1.5% and 1.8% between 2010 and 2022. China, on the other hand, has maintained a significant lead over India with a share of 10.3% to 13.8% in global export of merchandise since 2010. China's advantage in labour-intensive manufacturing at scale, backed by low labour costs and investment in trade-related infrastructure, has enabled it to move towards cutting-edge sectors like robotics and aerospace through the 'Made in China 2025' campaign.

China's export-oriented approach focused on industries with higher export potential and invested in skilling its labour force, allowing for easier technology absorption and movement up the global value chain. In contrast, India struggled to achieve the desired level of skilling, leading to export inefficiency. India's weak infrastructure, which only uses 3% of its GDP for infrastructure construction

each year, is a significant flaw for the manufacturing sector. India's surface transportation systems cannot meet the expectations of modern high-speed logistics, which is crucial for efficient manufacturing.

The fusion of intelligent digital technologies into manufacturing and industrial processes, known as Industry 4.0, presents an exciting opportunity for a new industrial revolution. This includes industrial IoT networks, AI, Big Data, robotics and automation, additive manufacturing, simulation, system integration, cloud computing, and cybersecurity. The objective is to enable autonomous decision-making in real-time, with the involvement of all stakeholders from the beginning. The manufacturing industry is poised for growth, especially with the Make in India initiative at an inflection point. To build a successful "Brand - Made in India," several things need to happen. The government should continue to build physical infrastructure and promote ease of doing business while also funding Industry 4.0 through start-ups. They should implement the NRF to attain leadership in technologies of national importance and build a future-ready workforce. The manufacturing sector needs an inspirational leader to drive Industry 4.0 as a movement until India becomes the third-largest manufacturing economy.
